16 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that this matter shall be briefed by
17 the parties in accordance with the terms of this order;

18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that petitioners shall file a brief in chief on or
19 before **December 20, 2021**, with one answer brief from respondent and one answer
20 brief from respondents-intervenors due thirty (30) days after service of the brief in
21 chief, and petitioners' reply brief, if any, due six (6) days after service of the
22 answer brief;

23 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties' briefs shall conform to the

1 length limitations and other applicable requirements in Rule 12-318 NMRA; and

2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that oral argument shall be heard on Tuesday,
3 March 1, 2022, at 9:00 a.m.
