LOTTERY AND FEES

- Annual lottery for the following year.
- If you've applied to the lottery for the next year, you'll get notices
 of cancellations in that year.
- Fees
 - \$25 for lottery application, once per launch year
 - \$200 small trip deposit, \$400 standard trip deposit
 - \$20 park entrance fee per person
 - \$90 river permit per person
 - \$100 per person added after permit issued
- Use those Senior Park Passes, they are worth 4 people at \$20 ea.



KITCHEN AND FOOD: MENUS AND DIETS

- Menus
 - Amount of food
 - Balance between having plenty of food and not having to store leftovers
 - Use open containers of food and leftovers
 - Snacks left up to the individual
- Allergies and preferences
 - Sensitivities to nuts, sugar, gluten
 - Vegetarian

Don't go crazy with amounts of food!

Allergies

Sirius - Pistachios food allergy

Hermione - yogurt - can only eat Brown Cow brand

Mr. Weasley, Harry, Mary - penicillin

Ronald, Mrs. Weasley - wasps

Neville - gluten sensitive

Preferences

Mrs. Weasley - Vegetarian - I do enjoy dairy, don't eat a lot of eggs but can do, will eat some fish but just not a fan of canned fish or fish mixed with other foods such as tuna salad etc.

Remus - vegetarian except occasional fish

Hagrid is an insulin dependent Type 1 Diabetic

KITCHEN AND FOOD: FOOD STORAGE

- Cooler strategies
 - Early and later coolers
 - Freeze 3" water in second-halfof-trip cooler at local grocery store or use dry ice. Don't open till needed.
- Block ice
 - Basha's in Tuba City
 - Canyon REO has high density ice (for sale?)
- Dry boxes for cans and durable foods

Notes:

Dutch ovens are primary cooking vessels for use on the stove top and well as with coals for baking.

The rectangular dutch oven fits over two burners on a 4 burner partner stove (holds a lot of food)

The larger stockpot is typically used for heating river water for washing dishes

The smaller stockpot is ued for heating water for pasta but burns super easy if used for cooking

A 14" dutch oven ?

Bring any spices, cooking oils, and fancy knives/utensils that your cooking needs

 - Breakfast
 - Cook group packs up personal gear while everyone else takes down the kitchen

CAMP: FIRES

- Bring own firewood March 1 through October 31
- Can collect driftwood from beaches
 November 1 through end of February
- Need fire pan 300 sq inches, 3" lip, elevated with legs.
 - Required Nov 1 through end of February, if having wood or charcoal fires
- Briquettes may be in firepan 12"x12"x3"


- Groover boxes (rocket boxes)
 - # people x 1 use per day x # of days / 60 uses per rocket box
 - $16*1*20 / 60 = 5.33 \rightarrow 6$ boxes
- Big pee bucket (5 gal)
- Signal and markers

- Supplies (rocket box); stores:
 - Toilet seat
 - Several rolls of toilet paper; divide the rest among different rafts
 - Wipes and separate disposal container
 - Hand cleaners
- Daytime groover or Wagbags
- Individual nighttime pee buckets

CAMP: GROOVER SETUP

- Take supplies and groover box to location
 - Without pee bucket, locate next to the river
 - With pee bucket, can locate anywhere
- Arrange supplies and rocket boxes
- Need sidewalls for privacy?

- Mark trail to the groover
- Place "occupied" signal and handwashing station at start of the trail
- Tell everyone where it is

- On the river
- Medical
- Rescue equipment

SAFETY: ON THE RIVER

- Communicate intentions
- Review signals: stop, go left, go right, eddy out, come on down
- See the boat in front of you
 - If can't see, move faster
- See the boat behind you
 - If can't see, stop

- Individual 1st aid kits
 - See Regulations for injury stabilization, relief of discomfort.
- What's in the Major Medical Kit?
- Medical, insurance and contact information for participants
- Injuries
 - Assessment by a designated medical officer of concerns
 - JW: person with renal stone was evaluated at Phantom Ranch, felt better, then had recurrences at Randy's Rock and Upper Owls Eye
- When to evacuate

RESCUE: BOAT FLIPS

- Boat flips
 - Prepare ahead of time
 - Set up rescue boats at the bottom/middle of difficult rapids
 - Plan procedure to flip
 - Communication with the crew during the process

RESCUE: LOGISTICS OF EVACUATION

- Communication with Rim World
 - Satellite phone, ground-to-air transceiver, inReach
 - Signal mirror
- Location for evacuation
 - Where on the river?
 - 15'x15' space
- Orange markers
- Wet the sand
- Rotor downwash stay 100 ft away

RESCUE: EVACUATION COST

- Take a phone calling card or credit card
- Inner canyon helicopter covered by the "tax payer"
- Ground transport and supporting commercial aeromedical transportation is the financial responsibility of patient
- If the passenger is unable to pay, the Trip Leader/ permittee will be responsible for the cost
- Check your insurance policy
